- Ensuring that work activities do not adversely *affect* the health or safety of employees or anybody else.
- Consulting with all employees, on a regular basis. concerning their health and safety, through toolbox talks, practical demonstrations, detailed induction program and formal Committee meetings.
- Ensuring that all plant equipment is safe and full training has been provided to the relevant people.
- Ensuring that all necessary safety devices and protective equipment are fully functional and to correct industry standards, through daily inspections. To ensure that safe and healthy working conditions are maintained at all times, through inspections and audits, to the standards of ISO45001:2018.
- To ensure compliance with relevant health and safety legislation, including the Health and Safety at Work (Northern Ireland) Order 1978, the Health and Safety at Work etc. Act 1974 (UK), the Safety, Health and Welfare at Work Act 2005 (ROI) and other requirements related to our operations.
- To monitor and review the health and safety systems as frequently as necessary, always keeping them up to date.
- To set and achieve our health and safety objectives and targets.

All employees have the responsibility to:
